Commodore's Message

February is already here and the good weather is making me itch to get my boat in the water and start the sailing season.

The year is shaping up to be a busy season with lots of events. CBYC will not only be hosting the SJ21 nationals, but also the Geary 18 nationals, back to back regattas Woo Hoo what fun! I want to thank George & Carol Tinker for putting on another great Muster at OIMB, we had a good turnout and everything went very smooth. Gordon Gates is doing a great job of putting together an interesting boat show. It sounds like we are going to have a wide variety of boat types represented at the show; canoe, airboat, Geary 18, SJ21, MC Scow, laser and maybe even a custom boat. If you're interested in helping with the boat show contact Gordon, I'm sure we can use additional volunteers.

Our first racing event "**The Commodores Cup**" will have a change of venue this year, rather than the traditional potluck at 12:00, **we will have our scheduled racing start at 12:00, yearbook and new key distribution will be at 3:30, the membership meeting, followed by a dinner hosted by the Junior Sailors. The dinner will be a fundraiser for junior sailing and we are hoping to have a good turnout.** This is a great opportunity for the adult sailors to meet the Junior Sailors and support the Junior Sailing program. At the January Muster we voted on two policy changes, adding the boat yard to the moorage policy and the dues adjustment. Both passed and rounding up to the nearest dollar amount was the winner of the dues adjustment.

As you're reviewing your annual dues statement, you may notice that the published annual dues were \$251.83 (2010 amount) so rounding up to the nearest dollar the 2011 dues would have been \$252.00, on your statement the dues for 2011 is \$256.00. Thus the confusion, I did not add the Portland CPI to the 2010 amount prior to publishing. The numbers used were examples based on 2010 dues and were not meant to be indicative of the actual 2011 membership dues. The CPI is 1.6% adding \$4.03 to 2010 dues bringing the total to \$255.86 rounded up to the nearest dollar, 2011 dues are \$256.00. A separate billing for members with additional boat slips will be sent out soon. I apologize for any confusion.

CBYC Members: Here's your chance to learn to row!

Basic instruction in how to scull a racing shell will be offered to CBYC club members on May 21, 22 and 23. Individualized classes will be offered, one for each of 8 club members registering in advance. Classes will convene at the racing shells above the boat launch at the following times:

Saturday morning, May 21 at 6:00, 7:30 and 9:00.

Sunday morning, May 22 at 7:30 and 9:00.

Monday morning, May 23 at 6:00, 7:30 and 9:00.

There is no fee. All equipment will be provided. You should dress in close-fitting (no bulky jackets) clothing, in layers, so you can peel a layer or two as you warm up. Bring a bottle of water. You'll be rowing in a two-person racing shell called a double (2x). Although flipping a 2x is rare as hen's teeth, it has happened, and since rowers do not wear life vests, you must be able to swim.

CBYC members Don and Karen Costello will provide the instruction. Don taught Karen how to row seven years ago and she has been at it ever since. Don began his rowing career at Cal, where he competed in intercollegiate crew 1966 – '69. During the 1970's, he was varsity crew coach at U. of Oregon, and he founded, and coached, several club and college programs in Portland. A co-founder of one of the clubs, the late Fred McMillan (a former OSU oarsman) was the father of CBYC member Sarah Recken.

After all these years, Don still rows 4 -6 days a week and competes in masters regattas in the U.S. and Canada. He says he has yet to find anything he enjoys more than to sit out in the elements and go backward with gusto! Give it a try! Maybe you'll get the bug as well.
