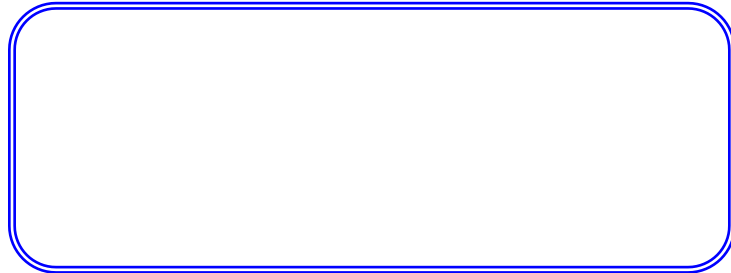

2. Playground update- the playground arrives March 17<sup>th</sup>. Scott Johnson helped move sand (48 yards) with the excavator. The road now connects with the playground and it looks good.
3. There were about 30-35 people who attended the yummy Valentine's Day breakfast provided for by the board.
4. Safety boat trailer-When Thad took the Chase boat to the marina for its tune-up the trailer fell apart. Garth Frost found a trailer for \$200. A Motion was made to buy this trailer for \$200. Tom Kyle will dispose of the old chase boat trailer (that fell apart).

Dick Vigue, Ann Waldrop and Shari Main met to discuss and review membership procedures and past practices.

1. All members receive a new cut key at the April General meeting and potluck if their account is paid in full. Keys and yearbooks of those not attending will be mailed.
2. New members receive a letter welcoming them to the club after they are approved for membership at a general meeting. They are reminded that full membership begins when all is paid in full. A key and yearbook is sent to them.
3. Renewing members will be dropped if they are not paid by May. This will be an automatic drop.

**New Recommendation:**

4. There will be two open memberships a year- April 1<sup>st</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup>. *#4 was discussed and tabled.*
5. New members that are voted on and paid prior to April 1<sup>st</sup> pay and complete 100% of dues and work hours. After April 1<sup>st</sup>, new members will be responsible for 50% of work hours and dues.

There is some lumber left over and more lumber will need to be purchased to complete four sections of docks. A motion was made to approve the spending of up to \$3500 to purchase lumber and parts.

**Director Drew Miller** made up a new chart for mooring assignments. It will be posted in the clubhouse. Let him know of any changes.

**OAC (Richard Rudder)** - Space #16 and #21 are vacant. Any trailer moving or switching needs to be approved by the OAC committee. All requests for sites or changes are to be in writing.

**Measurer Perry Wickham-** The Boat Show is scheduled for March 31, and April 1<sup>st</sup> at the Pony Village Mall in North Bend. So far, eight boats will be put in. Perry has the lay out. It was suggested that signage for each boat be made stating type and name of each boat, and the owners name with a possible picture. The boats can come into the Mall after 8:00 Friday. There will be a display area featuring boating safety. A Boat Show Social will be held at the home of Tom and Jean Kyle on Saturday March 31 at 6:00. Boats are to be removed Sunday after the 6:00 p.m. closing of the Mall.

**Director Claudia Moore-**Race/Yearbook/Yacht Yak

The 2012 yearbook is complete and off to the printer. It includes final duty lists.

**Director George Tinker- Safety** - The Chase Boat has been tuned and a trailer has been found.

The newly purchased defibulator has been installed by the work hour log area. There is a five minute video that needs to be watched. It was noted that Keri Odendahl-Miller is a CPR and AED trainer.

A design and bid for a new cabinet was shown to house these supplies. A design was also shown for a big wall cabinet that could be built for more storage. This is for the large wall facing the kitchen. All cabinets will match the kitchen cabinets. The larger cabinet will be considered at a later time as it was not budgeted.

**Sailing School (Junior)-** Junior Sailing School is scheduled for June 19- 23. George has expressed the need for an understudy for this year for the Junior Sailing School. After 27 years as the leader, he feels it is time for him to end this role. He will continue to help, but needs to pass on this commitment.

## Boating Class to obtain the Boater Education Card

The US Coast Guard Auxiliary will conduct an 8 hour boating safety education course on Saturday, April 28, 2012 in Charleston. The course covers the basics of boating safety, rules of the road and Oregon boating laws. A test at the end of the course will qualify boaters for their Boater Education Card, under the Oregon Mandatory Boater Education Program. The Boater Education Card is required for all motorboat operators of all ages for boats over ten horsepower. Additional provisions apply to youths. The cost of the course and materials is \$15.

Pre-registration is required. To register for the class, please call George Tinker, (541) 267-6152.
