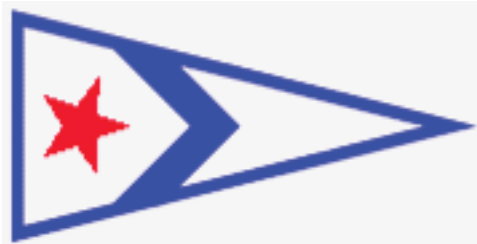

It is that time again.....

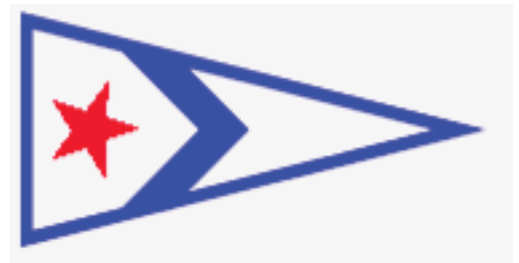
