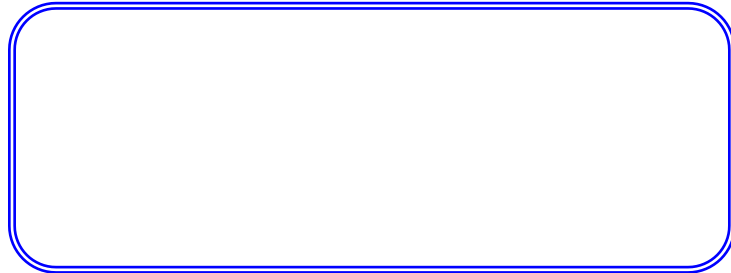

CBYC has installed an Automated External Defibrillator device in the Clubhouse. It is mounted next to the Ships Store, above the Work Hours Logbook. On July 22 beginning @ 11am (before Potluck) certified trainer and CBYC member, Keri Miller, will be holding a training class. Although the device has simple audio commands, please come to get some hands on training.

As POLICY #6 states:



ALCOHOL: There shall be no public consumption of alcoholic beverages in the clubhouse during potlucks, board meetings, and general meetings. Public consumption of alcoholic beverages shall
