# CBYC Fire Policy

Coos Forest Protection Association has burning restrictions in place applicable to CBYC. The only open flame/ fire locations permitted are the fire ring at the point and the clubhouse BBQ pit for club functions. Both are required to be attended to and fire extinguished at the conclusion of each use. Available water and fire tools are required to be present. For CBYC the areas around trailer furnaces, hot water heater, and refrigerator hot exhausts need three feet of "bare dirt" clearance or equivalent recommended by the Lakeside Fire Chief.

## Clean Marina Program

The Coos Bay Yacht Club Board incorporates the Clean Marina Program as adopted policy for its operational procedures. All Federal, Oregon, and local laws shall be followed along with the best management practices of the Clean Marina Program adopted as CBYC Policy. A Coos Bay Yacht Club Emergency Response Information book is available at the club house and Safety Locker (at the point).

## Fire Safety and Protection Policy

The Coos Bay Yacht Club is currently outside of the Lakeside Fire Protection boundaries; however they will respond to a fire and assess a fee along with the Coos Forest Protection Association. All Coos Forest Protection Association regulations in effect are to be followed by all club members and guests.

The following policy has been adopted by the CBYC Board in the interest of protecting the assets of the club and following the recommendations of the Lakeside Fire Protection District Fire Chief.

1. Each trailer site owner is to maintain a fire defensible space around the trailer of three (3) feet of bare dirt (no brush) with special attention to the location of trailer furnaces, hot water, and refrigerator exhausts. Overhead tree limbs above trailers are to be removed by the trailer site owner.
2. Use of liquid fueled camp stoves, heaters, and lanterns used in association with camping and trailer sites is prohibited on all CBYC property. Propane fueled stoves, heaters, and lanterns units are acceptable when used over non combustible surfaces, secured and elevated from the ground. Charcoal briquettes BBQ units shall be elevated and used over non combustible surfaces. Ash from briquette BBQ must be disposed of only in the fire pit at the point. Stoves, heaters and fueled lanterns of all types are prohibited inside tents. Only battery powered lights may be used inside tents.
3. Open fires initiated by individual club members are only permitted at the Observation Point fire ring.
4. Clubhouse fireplace fires are to have cold ashes removed prior to starting a new fire. Upon conclusion of an activity, the fire is to be knocked down and dispersed within the fireplace to reduce fire risks. Only wood and other natural materials may be burned.
5. Personal smoking cautions and etiquette require cigarettes to be disposed in non combustible containers to insure self extinguishing.
6. Club sponsored activities with a designated responsible member in charge may have an open fire pit at the outdoor BBQ cooking site adjacent to the clubhouse. The surrounding site shall be soaked with water prior to starting the fire and have a working water hose readily available. The open fire pit shall be extinguished upon completion of use each day by soaking the soils with water.
7. Club sponsored work parties with a designated responsible member may have an open fire brush burn pile located adjacent to the boat ramp. Such brush burning shall conform to local laws and restrictions in place at the time. The surrounding site shall be soaked with water prior to starting the fire and have a working water hose readily available. The open fire shall be extinguished upon completion of use each day by soaking the soils with water. Brush piles shall be limited to manageable burning size. Only brush and other natural materials may be burned.
8. All combustible and flammable materials (club owned and personal) shall be stored in the storage shed adjacent to the boat hoist.
9. The Safety Locker (facing the lake, adjacent to the observation deck) shall remain unlocked and contain additional fire extinguishers to service the CBYC Emergency Response Plan and members first response to an out of control fire incident. An oil spill response boom, life rings, throw lines, and other safety equipment shall be contained in the same locker.
10. The Club shall maintain a fire extinguisher in the vicinity of the docks as a part of the CBYC Emergency Response Plan.
11. In the event a Lakeside Fire Protection District response is required, the access road shall be vacated of all vehicles and the LFPD shall have control of all road entrance and egress. They are prepared to cut the gate lock.
