Board Meeting on October 2, 2013

Infrastructure Committees

BOAT STORAGE: (Tom Benz) Please clean-up your space in the shed and/or yard. Dispose of boats and trailers no longer in use. Do not block access to shed by parking too close.

Per Club Policy #8, members will be charged an extra \$50 for each boat/trailer in the storage yard. Each trailer is to have a name tag; contact Gordon Gates if you want one made.

After November 15th, the boat yard will be organized and cleaned-up including disposing of orphaned trailers (without a boat) and unclaimed boats. Please claim your boats and trailers now.

MOORINGS & DOCKS: (Richard & Lynne Biasca) Old docks will be removed and lights on docks will be repaired. The club will give the old docks to anyone who wants them.

ROADS & GROUNDS: A few trees came down during the big storms. P P & L cut down a few trees/branches to gain access to the lines.

WATER: Turn off water for your trailers and hoses when you leave the Club. In the winter, it is best to disconnect hoses from your trailer in case it freezes.

WORK PARTY: (Ken Labrousse) Next work party will be held starting at 9 AM on Saturday, October 19th to close up the Club for the winter. Work will include moving the Holder Hawks off the dock into their cradle by the clubhouse, cleaning the club house refrigerators/freezers, debris removal, and so on.
