# Board & Committee Notes

Board Meeting on September 4, 2013

## Infrastructure Committees

**BOAT STORAGE:** (Tom Benz) Please clean-up your space in the shed and/or yard. Dispose of boats and trailers no longer in use. Do not block access to shed by parking too close.

Per Club Policy #8, members will be charged an extra \$50 for each boat/trailer in the storage yard. Each trailer is to have a name tag; contact Gordon Gates if you want one made.

After November 15<sup>th</sup>, the boat yard will be organized and cleaned-up including disposing of orphaned trailers (without a boat) and unclaimed boats. Please claim your boats and trailers now.

**MOORINGS & DOCKS:** (Richard & Lynne Biasca) Old docks will be removed and lights on docks will be repaired.

Discussion of adding more signage to docks and beach due to non-members using facilities, entering from the water.

Gordon Gates will get CAD drawings of dock assignments and print tags for each space.

**ROADS & GROUNDS:** Generally in good shape. The trees and bushes overhanging and crowding the roadways need to be cut back.

The Boater Education Card is required for all motorboat operators of all ages for boats over ten horsepower. Additional provisions apply to youths.
